A Financial Coach works with you one on one to find out your financial goals and help you reach them.

Who Does the Coaching?

All Financial Coaches are trained Accounting Aid Society volunteers. They are here to support people like you. People who want to better their financial situation and could use some support and guidance.

How Does Financial Coaching Work?

Your Financial Coach will meet with you in person or over the phone twice a month for six months. Your coach will take the time to get to know and understand you. They will help you visualize your goals and plan steps, both large and small, to achieve them.
